Controls crabgrass, pigweed, common chickweed and other listed weeds.

Rates

- *Apply 13-0-5 at 4 pounds per 1,000 square feet.*
- *Ensure your spreader is calibrated properly.*
- *Water grass thoroughly 1/2 inch at least 1-2 days before application.*
- *Apply before annual grasses emerge.*
- *Most effective weed control in turf grasses will be obtained when this product is activated by at least 1/2 inch of rainfall or irrigation within 14 days after application and prior to weed germination.*
- *Wait 6-7 weeks to fertilize again.*

Rates

- *Apply 15-0-5 at 4 pounds per 1,000 square feet.*
- *Ensure your spreader is calibrated properly.*
- *Ensure areas being fertilized are not overly saturated.*
- *Suggested application for our area depends on feeding habits of pests.
(see label or ask us)*
- *Lightly irrigate after application but allow rainfall to move the product into the soil.*
- *Not suggested on vegetable gardens, near fish pools, ponds, lakes or streams.*
- *Wait 6-7 weeks to fertilize again.*

Soil should be tested prior to using this product. Potassium helps regulate plant metabolism and is important for good root development.

Rates

- *Apply 0-0-60 at 1-2 pounds per 1,000 square feet (depending on results of soil test)*
- *Ensure your spreader is calibrated properly.*
- *Apply 1 lb per 1000 sq. ft. spring and/or fall for best results.*
- *Water thoroughly after application.*
- *Do not apply in temperatures over 85 degrees.*

Establishment and Maintenance

For best results, seeding rates are 4-6 lbs per 1,000 square foot. Cutting heights should be maintained from 1.5 inches to unmowed. The 6 lb. seeding rate will reduce early summer seed head development where left unmowed. For optimum performance and stress tolerance, fertilize no more than 2 lbs of nitrogen per 1,000 square foot per growing season with not more than 1 lb. of nitrogen or potash per application.

Recommended Seeding Rates

New Seeding Rate: 175-250 lbs/acre

- *Over Seeding Rate: 130-175 lbs/acre*
